Cricketers House is coming along nicely!

The brickwork and stonework on the building is now 95% complete with only the lift shafts to be completed. All front doors and windows to the new build apartments have been fitted. We have installed the dormers and completed the roof works. The scaffolding is now being removed to reveal the brand new building.

Over the next few weeks we will start to facilitate the groundworks of the site. Internally we will be completing the fit out works to the respective floors, with dry-lining works, kitchen installations and carpentry coming in line with internal doors being fitted.

The development is on time and scheduled for completion Autumn 2018.


